

## 12 Hour Paediatric Course

This Paediatric First Aid course aims to provide students with training in first aid on Paediatric Emergency's. It exceeds the required standards for CSSIW first aid requirements in Wales for nurseries and child minders. The course also meets OFSTED and NVQ Requirements.

### Course Outcomes

#### This course covers

- **basic adult first aid skills**
- **details on accident reporting**
- **administering medication for those working in a childcare setting.**

#### This course also includes the following topics.

##### How to help a child or baby who:-

- Is unresponsive and breathing
- Is unresponsive and not breathing
- Is choking
- Is bleeding
- Is burnt or has a scald
- Has an object in their eye, ear or nose
- Has hypothermia or heat exhaustion
- Has sickness or fever
- Has a medical emergency, including:
  - Meningitis
  - Diabetic emergency
  - Seizures
  - Asthma attack
  - Severe allergic reaction (Anaphylactic shock)
- Has an injury to a bone or muscle or joint (including spinal injuries)
- Has a head injury
- Has swallowed something harmful

### Target Audience

- This course is for learners who work with young children and babies.

### Pre-requisites

- **Learners must be:-**
  - Physically able to participate the practical course elements
  - Able to attend all sessions
