This course is approximately ½ day dependant on group sizes and aims to cover asbestos awareness to delegates that may be exposed to asbestos as part of their work. Delegates will understand the dangers and can avoid any work which may disturb asbestos.

Course Summary

Asbestos training is essential for employees whose works involve potential risk of exposing asbestos. Regulation 10 of the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2006 (CAR 2006) holds employers responsible to ensure that their employees have completed relevant asbestos awareness training so that they are aware of the potential dangers and the procedures they must follow in the event they are working in the vicinity of asbestos containing materials (ACMs).

Course Outcomes:

- Requirements of the Control of Asbestos at work
- Properties of asbestos and effects on health and the associated health risks
- Locations where asbestos is commonly found and practical controls for asbestos safety
- General procedures to be followed when dealing with an emergency in the event of the uncontrolled release of asbestos dust in the workplace
